

# LIMERICK FOREST FORSYTHE SOUTH

Limerick Forest is owned and managed by the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville with assistance from the Friends of Limerick volunteer group. Limerick consists of approximately 5,800 ha's of forest and wetland situated in various locations throughout the United Counties.

The diverse ecosystems found in Limerick Forest support many species of flora and fauna. We encourage you to explore and enjoy the forest and all it has to offer. However, please remember the forest does not take care of itself. This is "your" forest so please take good care of it. Carry out what you carry in and "leave no trace". *Thanks – Enjoy the forest!*

### Trail Use

Limerick Forest is open to a wide range of recreational activities including hunting and motorized trail riding. Please exercise caution on the trails and respect other forest users. This is your forest so please look after it and remember...

- Use of the forest is at your own risk.
- Trails are multi-use and open for motorized and non motorized activities.
- Camping is restricted to scout or youth groups and by permit only.
- Cutting of trees or firewood and the digging of trees is prohibited.
- Hunting is allowed in accordance with provincial and federal regulations.
- The construction of permanent tree stands is not allowed.
- Dumping or littering is strictly prohibited.
- Camp fires are not allowed.

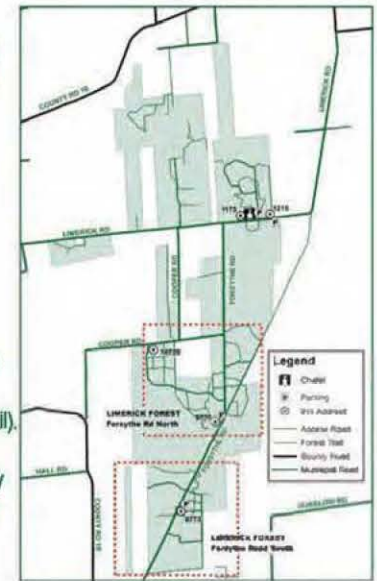

### Emergencies

To report an emergency call 911 and describe your location relative to the nearest intersection (eg. Forsythe Rd and Saunders Trail). These trails are maintained on a limited basis and are accessible by emergency vehicles except during winter conditions.

### Forest Fire Protection

Forest fires are a real threat in Limerick Forest. You can help protect Limerick Forest by avoiding smoking in the forest, lighting fires or operating motorized vehicles without spark arrestors. As forest users you are the first line of defense in the prevention and detection of fires. If you see a fire, please report it by calling 911 with the location relative to the nearest road intersection (eg. Forsythe Rd and Saunders Trail).
