Dear Residents, Families and Maple View Lodge Team Members;

**Re: Maple View Lodge Outbreak Update**

The COVID outbreak on Meadowview has affected additional residents therefore all residents living in this neighbourhood have been placed on tray services as of Sunday October 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Power of Attorney or Substitute Decision Maker of our affected residents have been notified. The Medical Director assessed residents earlier this morning.

All infection management protocols are in place to prevent the spread of this, or any other infection to others. At this time the outbreak continues to affect Meadowview only. There are no symptomatic or affected residents on Brookside. Twice daily surveillance assessments continue on all residents at the Home.

We continue to work in close partnership with our local Public Health Unit and Medical Director to ensure every possible step is taken to protect our Residents and Staff. We have been, and continue to follow all Public Health and Provincial Directives, to protect our Residents and Staff. We shall manage this situation and any potential subsequent cases to prevent further spread. The health and safety of our Residents and Staff remains our highest priority.

Maple View Lodge and the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville are committed to the privacy of any involved residents or staff members therefore, we appreciate your understanding that we are unable to share details about this case (or others moving forward).

At this time no general visitors to Meadowview will be permitted. Essential caregivers continue to be welcome to visit however limited to one (1) at a time. Scheduled visits to support residents in their rooms at meal times would be welcomed and helpful. Residents who are not COVID positive can be taken outside of room provided they wear

a mask, visiting in common areas with limited residents around. This would be of great benefit in reducing the boredom of isolation.

We ask that anyone entering the Home self-screen for any respiratory or other illness at Home *before* coming to Maple View Lodge. If you are experiencing respiratory symptoms, or have had contact with a person who has symptoms you must not visit the Home until symptoms completely resolve. If within 24 hours of visiting you develop symptoms, are COVID positive or have had contact with someone who is COVID positive please call and speak with the Charge Nurse at 613-802-0513 and you will have a follow up with Kirsten, the Infection Control Lead.

Maple View Lodge will post information, updates to our website, Social Media, and communicate fully with Residents, Families and Staff. We will monitor and support all stakeholders and work with Public Health and the Ministry to provide updates for our community to ensure transparency for our Residents and Staff. The United Counties of Leeds and Grenville will update local media on a regular basis.

Vaccination adds an additional layer of protection and we continue to encourage everyone who is eligible to get vaccinated and receive boosters when eligible. All eligible residents of the Home have been provided fifth 5<sup>th</sup> dose.
