Resident Care Conferences

We would like to share information in regards to Ministry required Resident Care Conferences. On admission, a six (6) week Post Admission Care Conference date is organized. Following this, Care Conferences are required on an annual basis. The purpose of the meetings is to review the residents care needs and goals of care providing an opportunity to voice concerns



and ask any questions. If you have an email set up with us, you will receive a notice from our automated system as a reminder of the meeting. At the current time, our Resident Care Conferences are conducted by telephone conference. REDEVELOPMENT UPDATE:

Key Achievements this Period (February 2022)

- Presented the Class B construction cost estimate to Committee of Management (COM).
- The potential value engineering (VE) list was drafted with the Project team. All (VE) items were reviewed, and presented to the COM. Final decisions were made on which items to include, exclude, or price separately with the general contractor tender process.
- Newterra kicked off the design development of the wastewater treatment system, including the application for the Ministry of Environment (MOE)
- Building permit fees were paid in full to allow issuance of the conditional permit.
- Many operational readiness activities in progress in collaboration with Colliers project management.
