

## COVID-19 Supports Funded by the Social Services Relief Fund (SSRF) in Leeds Grenville

Recently, the Provincial government announced a new Social Services Relief Fund (SSRF) in response to the COVID-19 crisis, which is a shared initiative between the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services.
