The family is responsible to maintain and clean the personal humidifier on a weekly basis to avoid mould and mildew.</p>	<p>MVL Broda Chairs Effective February 1, 2019 Maple View Lodge residents using home-owned Broda chairs will be contacted by Resident Services Supervisor, Lynn Vallee, to advise of a \$50 monthly rental fee to cover ongoing repairs and maintenance. We will provide residents or POA's with a written agreement for signature. If the Broda is no longer appropriate or the resident/POA no longer wishes to use it, monthly charges will cease on notification. A second option is to purchase a Broda chair. Our Physiotherapist, Sarah Emery, will assist with ADP application for subsidy. Typically ADP approval requires a valid reason and that a subsidy has not been used in five(5) years as considerations for eligibility.
