



What to Bring on Day of Admission

Long-Term Care Administration Division

Admission Allotted Time:

Approximately three (3) hour intake documentation.

Administration

- Health Card Number – Other Insurance Info – Veteran’s Card
- Social Insurance Card
- Birth Certificate
- **Basic Room** – Tax Notice of Assessment Form, Option C Printout (Statement of income)
- **Power of Attorney Documentation – Personal and Financial**
- Void Cheque - Pre-Authorized Payment Form (Admin. Services)
- Cheque for first payment due day of admission.
- Money (if opening a Personal Needs Trust Account)

Clothing

Clothing requiring dry cleaning, hand wash, wash cold, hang to dry, lay flat to dry, wool, suede, 100% nylon and silk **is not recommended** as these items will get damaged in the Home laundry process.

Move-in day, bring two (2) days of clothing labelled with a permanent marker to take to resident room (if possible).

- Suggested clothing list – We will label all clothing and put it away

7 Outfits – dresses or pant and top sets	4 Sweaters	2 Housecoats
7 Pairs of stocks	2 Pairs of shoes	1 Hat
7 Sets of undershirts / bras and panties	2 Pair of slippers	Razor (If applicable)
5 Night clothes	1 Seasonal jacket	

Personal Belongings – Each room is equipped with a bed, bedside table and a chair. We encourage personal belongings such as:

- Blanket/comforter
- Pictures (limited to 7)
- Plants (1 or 2) non-scented
- Clock
- Telephone

Depending on resident mobility, minimal extra furnishing is recommended for the safety of the resident's space and the safety of our nursing team to providing cares freely around a room.
