Highway 15 at County Road 42 Intersection

Public Notice

R. W. Tomlinson Limited has been awarded MTO Contract No. 2023-4098, which includes grading, drainage, granular base, hot mix paving, and electrical work required for the construction of the Crosby Roundabout. The work will take place at the intersection of Highway 15 and County Road 42.

We have now progressed into the next stage of construction and there will be a new detour route in place.

Those travelling North/South on Highway 15 will be able to proceed through the newly constructed roundabout to continue their travel on Highway 15 North/South and will also have access to CR 42 East/West.

Those travelling West on CR 42 will be able to proceed through the roundabout and continue to CR 42 or to turn onto Highway 15 North/South.

However, those travelling East on CR 42, will NOT be able to access the roundabout. Drivers must turn right on Highway 15 South and follow the designated detour route which will enable them to get back on to CR 42 or to access Highway 15 North.

This closure will go into effect on **July 20, 2026**, and is expected to continue until the end of August. Please see the detour route on the second page of this notice.

Please note that future notices will be distributed prior to changes to traffic flow and that residents will have access to their properties throughout the construction period.
