



BY – LAW No. 13-08

The Corporation of the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE NO PARKING ALONG DRUMMOND STREET (COUNTY ROAD 42) WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH JOHN, CARLETON, SIMCOE, MAIN AND NEW STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF NEWBORO, TOWNSHIP OF RIDEAU LAKES

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to designate no parking along Drummond Street (County Road 42) where it intersects with John, Carleton, Simcoe, Main and New Streets in the Village of Newboro, Township of Rideau Lakes; and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to designate the Township of Rideau Lakes, By-Law Enforcement Officer, Ken Gilpin as the Enforcement Agent;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE UNITED COUNTIES OF LEEDS AND GRENVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the penalties provided in Subsection (14) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against the by-law; and
2. **THAT** there be no parking along Drummond Street (County Road 42) where it intersects with John, Carleton, Simcoe, Main and New Streets in the Village of Newboro; and
3. **THAT** the Township of Rideau Lakes, By-Law Enforcement Officer; Ken Gilpin be designated as the Enforcement Agent.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed this 21st day of February, 2013.
