A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH AN ALL WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF SPRING STREET AND COUNTY ROAD 10 IN WESTPORT

WHEREAS the intersection at Spring Street and County Road 10 in the Village of Westport is presently controlled by a pair of stop signs on County Road 10; and

WHEREAS due to continuing increases in traffic volumes, increased speeds and sight distance restrictions; it is now deemed advisable to establish an "All Way Stop" to improve safety; and

WHEREAS Section 137 (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act* provides that the Council of a Municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs on highways under its jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE UNITED COUNTIES OF LEEDS AND GRENVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** an "All Way Stop" be established at the intersection of Spring Street and County Road 10; and
2. **THAT** the penalties prescribed by Section 214 of the *Highway Traffic Act* shall apply to offences under this by-law; and
3. **THAT** any By-laws or parts of by-laws contrary to or inconsistent with this By-law are hereby repealed.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 19th day of September, 2013.
